If left untreated, the infection may spread to other parts of the body within a few days to weeks. Symptoms include a loss of muscle tone on one or both sides of the face, severe headaches and neck stiffness due to meningitis, shooting pains, heart palpitations, neurological problems, dizziness and pain that moves from joint to joint. "Stephanie is disabled and can no longer work as a result of this devastating disease," he said. "Had we both received prompt and uncompromised medical care, we wouldn't be dealing with these health challenges."	
• Employment • Farmer's Market • Financial • Legals	The cost and side effects of the medications associated with chronic Lyme disease are substantial. According to Diers, medications for his wife, who also has other tick-borne co-infections, cost about \$70,000 to \$80,000.

"The challenge is that the symptoms are similar to other diseases and the tests for it are extremely inaccurate. Also, physicians are told we don't have Lyme disease in this area."

Education is the best prevention." Steps to prevent Lyme disease include using insect repellent, checking for ticks and removing them	
	promptly. Diers said a good repellent is Permanone, which is sprayed directly onto clothing two hours before it is worn and lasts through several machine washes.
